IW Norway:

1935 - The first club in Norway was in Bergen, established in 1935. It was the first club outside the British Commonwealth. And the first club president was Oda Irminger.



1959 - The first district in Norway was numbered D-36 and belonged to Eastern Norway. The president was Gyda Holmsen from Ekeberg, Oslo.

1966 – Divided into two districts.

1967 - Divided into three districts.

1968 – Divided into four districts.

1969 – Divided into five districts.

2020 - Merged into four districts.

In the year around ca.1980 - 1995 we were about 3300 members and 136 clubs, but today in 2023 around 660 members and 33 clubs.

IW Norway got the first National president/National representative in 1967. Eva Herud from Kongsvinger IWC

1962-1967: Norway have had 3 Council Member in the Association of IW-clubs in GB&I:

1962-1964: Gyda Holmsen, D-36/D-29,

1967-1965: Isabel Hvistendal, D-36/D-29

1965-1967: Eva Herud, D-36/D-30. She was also the first NP/NR in IW-Norway.

1967 The formation of NGB in Norway. Eva Herud was the first national president and national representative in International Inner Wheel.

IW Norway have been represented in the IIW Board since 1967 up until to today. We have had 3 IIW presidents and in the years 2021-2024 the Constitution Chairman: Sissel H Michelsen.
